



Project Superintendent

The Project Superintendent will lead and direct the project team, coordinate with other project teams for project resources, and report to the Director of Construction. We emphasize that everyone, in every role, is important to the successful outcome of the project.

Job Responsibilities:

- Must be able to read, understand, and interpret project design manuals, construction specifications and plan sheets.
- Must be able to plan, coordinate and orchestrate project resources including equipment, materials, labor, subcontractors, and anything else required to execute and complete the project.
- Must be able to operate heavy equipment including: excavators, dozers, farm machinery and off-road trucks required for the construction, maintenance, and repair of stream restoration projects. You will also be responsible for the care, maintenance and repair of the equipment.
- Must be able to direct that the team that will use hand tools such as sledgehammers, and a variety of other equipment and instruments. You will direct and coordinate the team to install coir matting, wooden stakes, filter fabric, safety fences or silt fences. You will direct and coordinate the team to spread seed, straw or assist other team members setup bypass pumps.

Body Positioning:

- Required standing and sitting sometimes for extended periods of time.
- Requires bending, twisting, walking, running, kneeling, crouching, stooping or crawling.
- Requires repetitive movement.
- Requires using hands to handle, control, or feel objects, tools or controls.
- Requires lifting more than 50 pounds at a time.

Environment:

- Requires working in extremely bright or inadequate lighting conditions.
- Requires working in very hot (above 90 F degrees) or very cold (below 32 F degrees) temperatures.
- Includes exposure to sounds and noise levels that are distracting or uncomfortable.
- Working in muddy ground conditions.

Activities:

- Operating a variety of heavy equipment and machinery.
- Signal to equipment operators to indicate proper equipment positioning.
- Clean equipment and facilities.
- Assist skilled construction laborers or others.
- Load or unload materials used in construction.
- Move construction materials to locations where they are needed.

Required Skills:

- Demonstrate active learning: Understanding the implication for both current and future problem-solving and decision making.
- Demonstrate active listening: Giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate, and not interrupting at inappropriate times.
- Speaking: Talking to others to convey information effectively.
- Reading Comprehension: Understanding written sentences and paragraphs in work related documents.
- Writing: Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.

Requirements:

- Minimum of 4 year of experience related to the job duties described and be **very** knowledge of heavy equipment operating principles.
- Minimum High School education.
- Reading Comprehension: Understanding written sentences and paragraphs in work related documents. Have a **strong** grasp of construction plans and documents.
- Experience with GPS Machine Grade Control is preferred.
- Specific knowledge of methods, materials and tools used in stream restoration and site preparation.
- Trade school is preferred.
