



## Heavy Haul Truck Driver

#### Key Responsibilities

- 2-5 years of experience
- Professional driving and operating of tractor-trailer road tractor
- Professional driving and operating of a tandem dump truck
- Operation of a lowboy trailer, including loading and unloading equipment onto the trailer
- Operation of log trailer
- Operation of half-road rock trailer
- Load and unload equipment on sometimes challenging job site, including heavy and large excavators, bull dozers, off-road trucks, and miscellaneous heavy construction equipment and materials
- Transport Over Dimensional and Overweight loads
- Inspect truck before and after each shift
- Inspect vehicles for mechanical items and safety issues and perform preventative maintenance
- Report any needed repairs to supervisor
- Document and log work/rest periods and miles spent driving and retain fuel/toll receipts
- Comply with truck driving rules and regulations (size, weight, route designations, parking and break periods) as well as with company policies and procedures
- Maneuver trucks into loading or unloading positions
- Operate equipment safely and efficiently in accordance with training and manufacturer's instructions
- Perform pre-shift safety inspection on the vehicle systems, equipment and accessories
- Ensure cargo is properly loaded and secure according to safety requirements
- Check to make sure loads are within legal height and width. If not, ensure that a permit is obtained
- Responsible for good housekeeping of equipment
- Assist in plant maintenance and repairs
- Assist with operation of other equipment as needed
- Perform duties with minimum supervision

- Non-automatic Class A CDL's with air brake endorsements
- Valid medical card
- Hazmat transport training is a plus
- In depth knowledge of construction procedures, equipment, and OSHA guidelines
- Ability to read a map or operate a GPS system
- Ability to communicate and report effectively
- Problem solving abilities
- High School diploma or equivalent
